

Treaty of Mutual Recognition

Between THE INDEPENDENT KINGDOM OF MARSANARYAS
and THE SULTANATE OF HUAJIANGSTAN

Haute-Vienne, August 18, 2026.



THE INDEPENDENT KINGDOM OF MARSANARYAS and THE SULTANATE OF HUAJIANGSTAN, wishing to establish peaceful and respectful relations, agree to the following articles in the spirit of sovereignty, cooperation, and mutual recognition.

I. Sovereignty

Both nations formally acknowledge and respect each other's full sovereignty, independence, and territorial integrity.

II. Mutual Recognition

Through this treaty, THE INDEPENDENT KINGDOM OF MARSANARYAS and THE SULTANATE OF HUAJIANGSTAN officially recognize one another as independent states, with equal status and dignity.

III. Diplomatic Relations

The two nations agree to establish peaceful diplomatic relations, including cultural, administrative, and cooperative exchanges.

IV. Non-Interference

Each nation shall remain independent in its internal affairs. No article of this treaty shall permit interference in national legislation or governance.

V. Human Rights & Peace

Both nations affirm that their relationship shall be guided by respect for human rights, peaceful coexistence, and goodwill between their citizens.

VI. Ratification

This treaty enters into force upon signature by the Heads of State of both nations.
